



Simple, easily memorized & reversible—just like a dishcloth should be!

## All Washed Up

Yarn: 1 skein Peaches & Crème  
Cotton Worsted Yarn Solid  
or Ombre; or similar yarn  
Needles: Size 6 or 7 Straights



Pattern: *x2 + Border*  
Row 1: K4, \*K\*, K4  
Row 2: K4, \*P\*, K4  
Row 3: K4, \*K1, P1\*, K4  
Row 4: K4, \*K1, P1\*, K4  
Row 5: K4, \*K\*, K4  
*Repeat Rows 1-5 for pattern*

Reversible stitch pattern reminded my DH of an antique washboard. Sample shown used 1/2 skein of Peaches & Crème. Needle size 6 used with 9 repeats between borders.

Cast on 36 stitches (or any even number to adjust the size of the cloth) & knit 4 rows in garter stitch. Begin pattern and knit until you are ready to add the last border. End on a Row 1, knit 4 rows in garter stitch & bind off. Weave in ends. Enjoy!

### Abbreviations:

K=Knit  
P=Purl

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
