Gauge: 18 sts = 4" (10 cm)

in Stockinette st

Size(s):

Baby, Toddler / Small child,

Older Child & Adult

Yarn(s): Kraemer Yarns Perfection Worsted

(30% U.S. Merino Wool/70% Acrylic)

Largest hat takes 2 ½ oz. of yarn CC and stripe colors as desired

## Knitting Needle(s):

US #9 (5.5 mm) 16" circular and dpn's

Or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Cable Needle Stitch, Stitch Marker & Large - eye darning needle for weaving in ends.



## Special Abbreviations:

KFB: K into front and back of st.

**BASIC HAT:** 

With #9 circular or dpn needles,

CO 64 (72, 80, 88) sts. PM and join into rnd being careful not to twist sts.

Band Ribbing: K 1, P 1; rep from \* for 1 -11/2"

**Body of Hat:** St st until hat is 4" (5", 6", 7")

from cast on.

**Crown Shaping:** change to dpn when necessary.

Rnd 1: \* K2tog, K6; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 2: K

Rnd 3: \* K2tog, K 5; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 4: K

Rnd 5: \* K2tog, K 4; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 6: K

Rnd 7: \* K2tog, K 3; rep from \* or rnd.

Rnd 8: K

Rnd 9: \* K2tog, K2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 10: K

Rnd 11: \* K2tog, K 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 12: K

Rnd 13: \* K2tog; rep from \* for rnd.

Remove marker. Cut yarn leaving a 10" tail and with darning needle draw yarn through rem sts, pull snug and weave in ends.

### Designer Note:

Use the basic hat pattern above as your foundation. Change the band, middle section and crown shaping using the following variations.

#### **BAND OPTIONS:**

choose band option below. Ribbing options:

Model B shows

\* K 1, P 1 \* or \* K 2, P 2 \* for 3" and fold up rib 1½".

Model F shows

Rnd 1: \* K second st first, then K the first st,

P 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 2: \* K 2, P 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Model G shows

K 1, P 1 \* rib.

Models H & I shows

K 2, P 2 \* rib.

Model J shows

K 1 tbl, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Model K shows

K 3, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Garter stitch:

Model C shows

\* K one rnd, P one rnd \* for desired length.

Rolled brim:

Model D shows

\* K all sts \*. Measure hat from point where hat stops rolling.

Hemmed options:

Model A shows

Rnds 1-6: K

Rnd 7: \* Yo, K2tog; rep for \* for rnd.

Rnd 8-13: K

Rnd 14: Fold to inside at Rnd 7, \* K st of CO

edge tog with next st on needle \*

Model E shows

Rnds 1-6: K

Rnd 7: P

Rnd 8-13: K

Rnd 14: Fold to inside at Rnd 7, \* K st of CO

edge tog with next st on needle \*.

For the above 2 options, you may skip rnd 14, and after hat is complete, fold to inside on Rnd 7 and sew with darning needle.



### MIDDLE SECTION OPTIONS:

after band is complete, choose middle section below.

## Model D shows Dot pattern

Rnd 1: \* P 1, K 3; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 2: K

Rnd 3: \* K 2, P 1, K 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 4: K

Rep Rnds 1-4 until ready for crown shaping.

Model G shows Open Hole Ridge pattern

Rnd 1 (with CC): K

Rnd 2: P

Rnd 3: \* Yo, K2tog; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 4: K

Rnds 5-10 (with MC): K

Rep Rnds 10-10 until ready for crown shaping.

Alternate Open Hole Ridge pattern: use MC only.

Model I shows Double Moss St pattern

Rnd 1-2: \* K 2, P 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnds 3-4: \* P 2, K 2; rep from \* to rnd.

Rep Rnds 1-4 until ready for crown shaping.

**Model J** shows Spiral Rib pattern (the rib will move 1 st to the left on each rnd).

Set up Rnd: K until 2 sts rem, K2tog.

Rnd 1: \* K 3, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rep Rnd 1 until ready for crown shaping.

## Alternate Spiral Rib pattern:

for a less steep spiral

Set up Rnd: K until 2 sts rem, K2tog.

Rnd 1: \* K 7, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rep Rnd 1 until ready for crown shaping.

## Stripe Options:

Model E shows

\*K 4 rnds of MC, then 2 rnds of CC \*.

Model G shows

\*4 rnds CC. then 6 rnds MC \*.

#### Model H shows

K 8 rnds of MC, 3 rnds of CC 1, 2 rnds of CC 2, 3 rnds of CC1, rem of hat MC.

## Alternate stripe options:

Change colors every 2 rnds, or every 8 rnds

### **Designer Note:**

With Reverse St st, start a new color only on a K Rnd.

## Cable Option:

Model B shows

Rnds 1-7: \* K 6, P 2; rep from \* for rnd. Rnd 8: \* Place 3 sts on CN, hold to back of work, K 3 sts, then K 3 sts from CN, P 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rep Rnds 1-8 until ready for crown shaping.



## Lace Options:

Model C shows

Rnd 1-2: K

Rnd 3: K4, \*yo, ssk, K6, repeat from \* until 4 sts remain, end yo, ssk, K2.

Rnd 4: K

Rnd 5: K2, \* K2tog, yo, K1, yo, ssk, K3; rep from \* until 6 sts remain, end k2tog, yo, K1, yo, ssk, K1.

Rnd 6: K

Rnd 7: Rep rnd 3.

Rnds 8 -10: K

Rnd 11: \* Yo, ssk, K6; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 12: K until 2 sts rem, K2tog.

Rnd 13: yo, K1, yo, ssk, K3, \*K2tog, yo, K1, yo, ssk, K3; rep from \* until 1 st remains in rnd., K1.

Rnd 14: K

Rnd 15: K1, \*yo, ssk, K6; repeat from \*, until 5 sts re-main, K5.

Rnd 16: K Rep Rnds 1-16 (ending with Rnd 8 or 16) until ready for crown shaping.

### **CROWN SHAPING OPTIONS:**

after middle section is complete, choose crown shaping section below.

Designer Note:

Sizes 2 and 4 will have some dec rnds that will end with an incomplete patt rep. Do as much of the rep as possible.

### Model B

conts Cable pattern, end after Rnd 2.

Rnd 1: \*K2tog, K 4, P 2; rep from \* for rnd. Rnd 2 and all even rnds: cont cable patt as est except K 4 sts instead of 6 sts.

Rnd 3: \* K 3, K2tog, P 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 5: \* K 4, P2tog; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 7: \* K2tog, K 2, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 9: \* K 1, K2tog, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 11: \* K2tog, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 13: \*K2tog; rep from \* for rnd.

Model C shows Garter St pattern P 1 rnd, K 1 rnd \*, working dec on K rnd.

Model D shows Dot pattern,

end after rnd 3.

Rnd 1: \* K2tog, K 6; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 2: \* P 1, K 2, P 1, K 3; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 3: \* K 3, K2tog, K 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 4: K1, \* P1, K2; rep from \* end K1.

Rnd 5: \* K2tog, K 4; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 6: \* P 1, K 1, P 1, K 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 7: \* K 2, K2tog, K 1; rep from \* for rnd.



Rnd 8: \* K 1, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 9: \* K2tog, P 1, K 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 10: \* P 1, K 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 11: \* K2tog, K 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 12: K

Rnd 13: \* K2tog; rep from \* for rnd.

Model F shows I-Cord finish

Dec as for basic hat until 16 [18, 16, 22] sts

rem

**72 st hat only:** K one extra rnd, with 2 dec evenly spaced in rnd.

**88 st hat only:** K one extra rnd, with 6 dec evenly spaced in rnd.

#### All sizes:

Place first 4 st on dpn, join CC 1, K 4 sts, do not turn work, pull yarn snuggly around back of work, K 4 sts again, sliding sts as needed. Cont until I-Cord is 6" long. BO by psso all sts over last st. Rep 4 st I-Cord 3 more times, changing colors as desired.

Fasten off top of hat and tie opposite I-Cords over each other.

Model I shows Double Moss pattern, end after rnd 4

Rnd 1: \* K2tog, P 2, K 2, P 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 2 and all even rnds: K or P sts as est.

Rnd 3: \* P 1, K 2, P2tog, K 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 5: \* K 1, P2tog, K 1, P 2; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 7: \* P 1, K 1, P 1, K2tog; rep from \* for

Rnd 9: \* K2tog, K 1, P 1; rep from \* for rnd. Rnd 11: \* P 1, K2tog; rep from \* for rnd. Rnd 13: \* K2tog; rep from \* for rnd.

Model J shows Spiral Rib pattern Move marker so it is after a P st. Move marker 1 st to the left every row. Follow decs for Model K, cont in patt as est.

Model K shows K 3, P 1 Rib pattern Rnd 1: \* K2tog, K 1, P 1, K 3, P 1; rep from \* for Rnd.

Rnd 2 and all even rounds: K or P sts as est. Rnd 3: \* K 2, P 1, K2tog, K 1, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 5: \* K2tog, P 1, K 2, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 7: \* K 1, P 1, K2tog, P 1; rep from \* for rnd.

Rnd 9: \* K2tog, K 1, P 1; rep from \* for rnd. Rnd 11: \* K 1, K2tog; rep from \* for rnd. Rnd 13: \* K2tog; rep from \* for rnd

Rnds may end with incomplete patterns.
