## Waffles Anyone by Annette Derksen

(c) May 15, 2010

Needles 4.5 mm

Cotton yarn variegated or color of

your choice

Slip yarn to back yb/ slip all slip sts purlwise

Pattern

Cast on 43 stitches

Borders Knit 3 rows.

Row1: K3, \*(yb SL1, K3) \* repeat to the last 4 sts end S1,K3.

Row2: K3 , \*PURL to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 3: K3 \* (yb Sl, P3) repeat \* to last 4 sts, S1,K3.

Row 4: K3 \*(P1, K3) repeat \* to last 4 sts. P1,K3.

Repeat rows 1-4 (13 more times) Repeat row 1 again. Bottom border :Knit 3 rows and cast off.

Sew in the ends.

Variation. Do 10 repeats of rows 1 to 4 in variegated color Then put in a solid color and do 1 more set of 4 rows Switch back to variegated color and repeat rows 1-4. Switch back to solid color and repeat rows 1-4.

Back to variegated for another pattern repeat of rows 1-4 (2 more times Repeat row 1 again before last border. Then knit 3 rows and cast off. Makes a very pretty striped color.

You can alter your pattern repeats with any colors and great way to use up the left over cotton yarns.

This is a fun cloth to make and makes great spa or dishcloths.
