## Suzanne's Diagonal Pet Blanket



Thank you to Suzanne from Noblesville, IN for creating another wonderful knitting pattern for us. It makes a perfectly sized pet blanket, at 37" wide by 24" in length. This blanket will be loved by a homeless pet for a lifetime!

**Supplies needed:** Size 13 knitting needles, 2 jumbo skeins of Red Heart Supersaver yarn (approximately 482 yards each). Note, there will be leftover yarn after making this blanket.

To begin: Cast on 100 Stitches using 2 strands of yarn.

**Next:** Knit 10 rows. These rows will act as your border.

**Begin left diagonal pattern:** The Pattern is worked in multiples of 6 stitches with 5 knit stitches on either end of your work to continue the knit border up the side of the blanket.

Rows 1 and 3: K5. \*P2, K4, repeat from \* till the last 5 stitches, K5.

Rows 2 and 4: K5. \*P4, K2, repeat from \* till the last 5 stitches, K5.

Rows 5 and 7: K5. K2. \*P2, K4 repeat across till the last 9 stitches, P2, K2, K5.

Rows 6 and 8. K5. P2. \*K2, P4 repeat across till the last 9 stitches, K2, P2, K5.

Rows 9 and 11: K5. \*K4, P2 repeat across from \* till the last 5 stitches, K5.

Rows 10 and 12: K5. \*K2, P4 repeat across from \* till the last 5 stitches, K5.

Next: Repeat the Left Diagonal Pattern 5 times more.

**Then:** Knit 10 rows. These rows will finish your border. Cast off and weave in ends.
