

LOSY (Left Over Sock Yarn)

Materials: About 2 ½ ounces (300 yards) of leftover sock yarn.

Needles: Set of size 6 double points and size 6 - 16" circular needle.

Gauge: 22 sts to 4" in pattern.

Pattern stitch: *K3, p1*, Repeat around row.

Basic Notes:

This hat is knit with 2 strands of sock yarn held together. When you run out of one color, pick up another.

Instructions:

Cast on 112 sts. Join in circle, being careful not to twist cast on row. Place marker. Knit in pattern (K3, p1) in rounds until hat measures 6 ½ inches.

Shaping the crown:

Round 1: *K1, k2tog, p1*, repeat around.

Round 2, 3, & 4: *K2, p1*, repeat around.

Round 5: *K2 tog, p1*, repeat around.

Round 6, 7, & 8: *K1, p1*, repeat around.

Round 9: *K2tog, k1, p1*, repeat around.

Round 10: *K2, p1*, repeat around.

Round 11: *K2 tog, p1*, repeat around.

Round 12: *K1, p1*, repeat around.

Round 13: *k2tog*, repeat around.

Round 14: Knit.

Round 15: *k2tog*, repeat around. 7 sts left.

Break yarn and draw thread through remaining sts. Draw up tightly and secure. Weave in all ends. Block and enjoy!
